- **Golf course:** I support the Golf Course Committee and councilmen who continue examining different options as any good business entity would do. I would ask that residents be allowed to vote on any major changes.
- **AF Canyon Land Swap:** Please visit the Cedar Hills Chat Room on Facebook. Let the city council know we would like a resolution stating that we do not support commercializing AF Canyon.
